The 3-year-old, 4-year-old, and 5-year-old programs here at Good Shepherd United Methodist Preschool stress all aspects of growth and development.

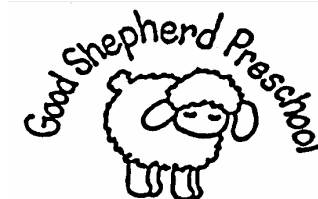

FEE SCHEDULE

Registration Fee - \$75.00

- **The last month tuition must be paid in advance.**
- **Tuition is due the first school day of the month. It is considered delinquent after the 10th day of the month.**

STAFF

All teachers at Good Shepherd have backgrounds filled with experience. Teachers are required to hold degrees, credentials or have the equivalent in post-secondary education. Each class has a full-time teacher's assistant. One important employment requirement for working at Good Shepherd Preschool is love of children. Each member of the staff is certified annually by a practicing physician to be free from any disability that would prevent them from caring for children. The entire staff has monthly planning sessions to share ideas and experiences in order to strive to keep our curriculum exciting and rewarding.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

Music Class

We have approximately 20-30 minutes instruction per class weekly. Music class is held in the sanctuary.



Field Trips

Field trips vary for different age groups. Our field trips may include:

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from school shall be the sole responsibility of the parents. A list of students' names, addresses and phone numbers will be available to preschool families when school opens to aid in forming carpools.

Good Shepherd offers an optional curb service program for your convenience. You have the option to drop off and/or pick up your child in front of the school; staff members will escort all children.



HOLIDAYS & SCHOOL CLOSINGS

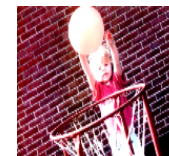
We observe the Prince William County Public Schools' holiday and inclement weather schedule. We make up snow days as needed. We are also closed for our staff to be able to attend the annual conference of the Virginia Association for Early Childhood Education (usually it is held in February).



FACILITY INFORMATION

Three spacious classrooms on main level and one on the upper level of the education building are all convenient to bathrooms and water fountains.

- Outdoor playground has modern equipment and is fenced.
- Indoor playground equipment is available for inclement weather and is set up in the narthex area when needed.
- The entire church (including all educational facilities) is asbestos free.
- The operation of the preschool is covered by public liability insurance, as part of the ministries of GSUMC.



**A nutritious snack (prepared in our kitchen on the main level) is provided each day. Occasionally we ask parents to provide a "Share A Snack" for their child's class.**

FAITH CURRICULUM

We have a twenty-minute Chapel Time twice-monthly in the sanctuary of the church. Once each month we have Chapel Talk that is taught by the Director of Christian Education from Good Shepherd Church or her designee. Once each month we have Chapel Music, taught by our Senior Pastor, in addition to our regular weekly music session.

We sing or say a table grace at snack time and Christian holidays are observed. Families find a loving Christian environment at Good Shepherd where children of all faiths are welcome.
